

Wake County Firefighter's Association Scholarship

The Wake County Firefighter's Association is proud to offer two scholarships, awarded annually. Each scholarship is \$500 to be used towards a course of study at a community college, college or university. One will be awarded to a firefighter, and one to a firefighter's child.

Instructions for the Application Form

The application form should be filled out completely and all questions should be answered in full. If you do not have sufficient room on the application form to answer the question completely, you may attach additional sheets of paper.

All references to "you" or the "student" contained in this application refer to the applicant and not to the applicant's parents. If you have a legal guardian (other than your parents), all references to your parent(s) refer to your legal guardian. Your legal guardian should provide the requested financial information.

If you are 25 years of age or older and are applying for this scholarship by virtue of your status as a firefighter, your financial information contained in Section F should be completed only for yourself. Do not include your parent's financial information.

Regardless of your age, if you are applying for this scholarship because your parent is a firefighter, you must include both your personal financial information and financial information for your parents.

The financial information provided on the form will be kept confidential.

If your parents are divorced and you are required to provide your parents' financial information on this application, you must provide financial information for both of your parents.

Please remember to sign the form. If you are required to provide your parents' financial information on this application, the parent(s) whose information is provided must also sign the form.

All applications are due for review by the selection committee **no later than 25 April 2010**. The recipients of the scholarships will be announced at the Association's quarterly meeting on Tuesday, May 10th, and the Zebulon Fire Department. The Scholarship award presentation will be at the August meeting at the Raleigh Convention Center.
