November 14, 2000

Starting in March there will be day classes scheduled back to back for five months. Starting in January Fire officer level 1 training will begin and will continue on a year around basis mainly at night for volunteer and career officers. There was an opening at Stony Hill Fire Department for a fire captain closing December 8th.

David Price gave a report on the State Fire College. It will be held June 15-17 with 300-400 estimated attendance. Dillard Drive Elementary is one candidate site.
